

**NOTICE AND PUBLISHED SUMMARY**  
**CITY OF CAREY ORDINANCE NO. 2023-03**  
**182 DAY LAND DIVISION MORATORIUM**  
*(PURSUANT TO I.C. § 50-901(A))*

Ordinance No. 2023-03 was considered by the City Council of the City of Carey, Blaine County, Idaho, and passed at its monthly Council Meeting on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2023. Said ordinance is an emergency ordinance entered pursuant to Idaho Code § 67-6523 and imposes a one-hundred and eight-two (182) day moratorium on accepting and processing building permits and development applications. The moratorium may be ended earlier by decision of the council. The moratorium is necessary to identify and repair damages discovered in the City's sewer system, and ensure the City maintains its ability to fulfill current and future obligations for providing sewer services.
